

Taught but Not Assessed

****Please read the 'Progress Reports Overview' document before reading this****

If your school would like to track where an objective has been taught to a class, but the teacher has not yet assessed the children without having a negative impact to 'on track/not on track' reporting; this can be done using a status that is set above target:

Status Colour	Status	Value	Target 
	Not Where You Should Be	0.00	
	Where You Should Be	1.00	
	Taught but not Assessed	1.00	

Setting the status to be above target is done by editing the statuses and dragging the status so that it is vertically below the status with the target indicator set. When the screen is saved, all statuses that are above target will have a shadow of the target indicator displayed against them (like in the screen shot above).

The 'taught but not assessed' status should be set to have the same value as the target status: See 'Student Progress Summary – Line Graph' section of this document

When objectives are set to this status in Student tracker, the following reports will display this status:

- Group Learning Objective Progress Summary
- Student Progress Summary by Subject
- Learning Objective Coverage by Phase of Curriculum
- Coverage Summary by Contextual Group
- Student Progress Summary by Assessment Period
- Student Progress Summary (Bar Chart)

Student Progress Summary – Line Graph

Setting the value of the 'taught but not assessed' status to be the same as the target status means that the student will show as being on track when this status is used.

NOTE: Provided that all other judgements are equal to or higher than the target status.

Assessment Period Summary

Setting the 'taught but not assessed' status to be above the target status means that the student will show as being on track when this status is used.

NOTE: Provided that all other judgements are equal to or higher than the target status.
